OUTDOOR AND SCENIC LIFE

A beautiful outdoor life can be explored by visiting the Rimrocks, Sacrifice Cliff, Pictograph Cave State Park, or Pompeys Pillar National Monument. Pompeys Pillar holds historical value from Lewis and Clark's journey and is just twenty miles out of Billings. Just south of Billings is the historic Little Bighorn National Monument.

Billings has **47 developed parks**, along with a dog park. billingsparks.org/parks

ZooMontana is Montana's only zoo and botanical park and is home to nearly 100 animals, with 58 species. zoomontana.org

Multiple waterparks can be found throughout the city such as The Reef Indoor Water Park, The Oasis, and Rose Park.

There are also endless places to go enjoy nature from the comfort of your vehicle such as a Sunday drive on the scenic Beartooth Bi-way or Chief Joseph pass. One of the world's most incredible scenic wonders, Yellowstone Park, is just a short Montana drive away.

A day trip to Red Lodge or Big Sky can ensure a fun filled day of skiing and snowboarding. There are numerous hobbies for each of the four seasons such as hiking, camping, fishing, mountain biking, snowmobiling, hunting, golfing, rafting, bird-watching, and boating.



EDUCATION

School District 2 includes 22 elementary schools, 4 middle schools, 3 high schools, and the career center. In addition to the 4 current middle schools, two new middle schools will be opening in the near future, one being Medicine Crow Middle School which will open in August of 2016 and Ben Steele Middle School which will open in August of 2017. billingsschools.org

ENERGY

Energy also plays a key role not only for Billings and Montana, but also the Midwest region.

A wealth of long-term energy resources has resulted in utility rates that are among some of the lowest in the nation.

Exxon-Mobil and Conoco-Phillips operate refineries in the Billings area, while Cenex-Harvest States runs an operation 20 miles away in Laurel, allowing Billings and Yellowstone County to be the oil-refining capital of the northern Rockies. Coal is a rich natural resource and water is plentiful and of excellent quality.
